Notice of Race



2017 Evening Series Dinghies *Thursday June 1 to September 7, 2017*

Rules

The races will be governed by the rules as defined in **The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020**, wherein the sailing instructions are the RStLYC 2017 Standing Sailing Instructions (SSI) and any addenda thereto with respect to this event posted on the Official Notice Board or the Clubhouse Notice Board.

Entries

Entries must meet the eligibility of a Club-Racing Event. Competitors shall register with the Race Committee Boat prior to the first Warning Signal on each evening.

To be eligible for Evening Series champion, 2nd or 3rd, boats must have raced:
-50%, rounded up, of the number of races sailed in the Evening Series for their respective class

-a minimum of 7 days of on the water racing

-for the Lightning class only: The decision to abandon/cancel the day's racing due to lack of wind or too much wind is at the sole discretion of the Principal Race Officer. Only once this decision has been made and the appropriate flags have been raised by the race committee to indicate the abandonment/cancellation, the Principal Race Officer will count the number of boats present for racing. If at least 3 boats are present, those boats may count the day as one of their minimum 7 days of on the water racing.

Schedule

The first signal will be at 1830 hours. Races will be run as long as the fleet representative agrees with the race committee that the amount of natural light will be sufficient for the race and the participants are willing to continue.

Scoring

The number of races to count shall be 70%, rounded up, of the number of races sailed for their respective class.

The Course

Courses will be posted on the Race Committee boat course board.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded at the RStLYC Annual Prize Giving Ceremony in November.
