RStLYC Recycling Guide

The recycling company will only accept the plastic film. When in doubt, remove anything other than the plastic film itself. **The recycling machine only processes plastic.** If you are using a service contractor to do the removal of the shrink-wrap, you are responsible to inform them of the process and that they adhere to it.

To ensure a smooth recycling process for shrink-wrap used during the winter season, please follow the steps outlined on the next pages.

Please note that shrink-wrap material should NOT be discarded in the Club's garbage containers.

The recycled material will be given a second life, contributing to a more sustainable future.

By following these simple steps, you're actively participating in our Club's environmental efforts and contributing to a greener future.

RStLYC Recycling Guide

1. Ensure the wrap is free of dirt, debris, and moisture. No other materials should remain on the film.
2. Remove all line, cords or other attachments used to tie down the shrink-wrap to your boat. These will not be accepted by the recycling company.

1. Remove any metal grommets or other type of attachment points from the plastic.

1. Remove any zipper type of access points made in the shrink-wrap. Our suggestion is to save this piece of material for future use. Reuse! Part of the



four “ R’s” . Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, and Recover, as well as avoid illegal dumping and littering.

After removing your shrink-wrap material, please follow these steps to prepare it for recycling:

1. Cutting: If needed, cut the shrink-wrap into smaller, manageable pieces.
2. Folding or Rolling: Fold or loosely roll the shrink-wrap into a manageable bundle

1. Drop-off: Bring your prepared shrink-wrap bundles to the assigned location.
